for the International Young Planning Professionals' SUSREG Workshop Wrocław, Poland, 29 May – 2 June 2014

BACKGROUND

Since 1991 ISOCARP has organized the Young Planning Professionals' workshops, intended to stimulate the professional interests and the development of planning skills of the youngest members of the planners' family. For this purpose ISOCARP is partnering with other institutions, including the national and local professional organizations as well as consortiums developed in order to elaborate the international cooperation projects.


Within this framework ISOCARP became a part of the SUSREG project consortium (www.susreg.eu) in 2013. One of the roles of ISOCARP within the scope of work of this project is to prepare and conduct the Young Planning Professionals' workshop. After careful examination of the possible partners, the Society of Polish Town Planners was selected as workshop partner.

OBJECTIVES OF THE WORKSHOP

The workshop aims to provide young planners responsible for or participating in the shaping and development of urban structures, with the principles and practices of effective contemporary urbanism and practical knowledge. The special focus will be on stimulating the use of sustainable energy resources and energy efficient methods in urban planning. Therefore, the workshop will be focused on improving knowledge, skills and attitudes of young professional planners.







The objective of the workshop is to provide the workshop participants with hands-on practical experiences. YPPs work in a studio setting under the *guidance of international experts* from among the members of ISOCARP and partner organizations. The project site will be chosen jointly by ISOCARP and other partners.

Besides the international experts, the local YPP coordinator will be assisting with workshop development and execution.

AUDIENCE

The workshop is targeted at young professionals, up to 35 years old. They come from various backgrounds such as architecture, civil engineering, spatial science technology and real estate management.

YOUNG PLANNING PROFESSIONALS' SUSREG WORKSHOP - THEME & SITE

The topic of the workshop was chosen with the participation of the local partners. It is associated with rethinking of planning and development policy of the historical district of the City of Wrocław, originating from the interwar period and now undergoing the process of significant changes and improvements. This is associated with many risks and issues, and one of them is the problem of energy efficiency.

More detailed information (including the "Workshop Brief") will be provided to the selected candidates prior to the workshop.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE FOR PARTICIPATION?

Candidates should have some basic planning skills. They should have a background in planning, urban design, social sciences, environmental sciences, energy planning, geography, or architectural studies.




