## 1. COLLABORATION W/ NDs





### Regional Workshops:

- Succeeded to partially revalorize NDs:
  - promoting activity at the national level as well as acrossborders;

  - participation from UK, Germany, Spain, Austria & ExCo.









- Polish ND Workshop, Lodz, 10-12/4/2014.
  - First ND to apply and receive the incentive fund.
- Dublin, 8-11/5/2014.
  - Following the great success of the London workshop the Scottish workshop was planned as a follow-up.

#### IMPP:

- provided continued support and helped seek entries.
- Current status:
  - Over 146 pledges; over 33 received contributions; ongoing negotiating w/ 25 countries; book design format agreed to; CD production under negotiation; seeking subeditors; seeking sponsorship / money from ExCo for production & printing.
- Finalized and submitted Egypt's contribution.
