Mentor & Student Research Lab (1)

Idea:

- Started new project initiative
- Pilot workshop in Gdansk, Poland
- 5 groups of 1 Mentor (international ISOCARP member) + 5-6 local students research a local problem
- Call for Mentors sent, positive reactions from Members

Process:




