Session in partnership with the Planning Institute of Australia

One of the highlights of the 2013 ISOCARP Congress will be a day-long session on 2 October presented in partnership with the Planning Institute of Australia.

The subject will be state-of-the-art planning systems around the world. Comparative examples will be drawn from the Australian states, all of which have their own mature planning systems that demonstrate both long and diverse traditions and frequent reform and innovation. An international panel will lead an interactive discussion and debate on planning systems - similarities and differences, local or universal, lessons to be learned.

With an annual city budget of \$A 2 billion (\$US 2 billion) the Brisbane City Council initiates ambitious planning projects, a number of which will be discussed during the day.
