Invitation

You are invited to join the International Society of City and Regional Planners (ISOCARP) in Bodø, Norway, for the 2018 World Congress. The congress will bring together decision-makers and politicians, leading urban managers, academics and practitioners as well as private sector from around the world to explore urban solutions related to climate change challenges, adaptation and mitigation, urban future, including aspects at all planning scales: metropolitan, urban, city centres, waterfronts, greenways, urban focal points, neighbourhoods and specific projects. High-level speakers will present and discuss urban solutions, plans, projects, case studies, researches, evaluations, theories and methodologies.

International Society of City and Regional Planners - ISOCARP

The International Society of City and Regional Planners (ISOCARP) is a global association of experienced professional planners. It was founded in 1965 in a bid to bring together recognized and highly qualified planners in an international network. The ISOCARP network consists of both individual and institutional members from over 80 countries. ISOCARP is a non-governmental organization recognized by the UN, UNCHS and the Council of Europe and has a formal representative status with UNESCO. The objectives of ISOCARP include the improvement of planning practice through the creation of a global and active network of planners. ISOCARP encourages the exchange between planners, promotes the profession in all aspects, stimulates research, improves education and training, increases information and awareness on major planning issues.

54th ISOCARP International Planning Congress

The Society's main event is the annual International Planning Congress, which focuses on an international planning theme. The congress takes place in a different country every year. In 2018, it will be held in Bodø, Norway, where more then 600 urban professionals and decision-makers from all over the world will gather to discuss the Congress theme "Cool Planning - Changing Climate and our Urban Future".

The agenda of the 54th Congress is ambitious. We believe the future of civilization depends on the way we plan and manage our cities and towns. Do we understand them as villains, victims, or saviours? Villains - because urban areas are the principal consumers and polluters of the tiny habitable layer on our planet we call the 'biosphere'. Victims - because half of humanity lives in urban areas, many of which are in climate risk-zones. Or saviours - because possible remedies and solutions can be more efficiently, more effectively and timelier applied only when populations are concentrated. Both the root cause of, and the solution to, the global climate crisis is fundamentally urban. Possible responses fall in two camps: sustainability (our aggregate efforts to mitigate the process of climate change) and resilience (the recognition that we also must prepare for, and adapt to, the inevitable impacts of changed climate). This call thus recognizes that human-induced climate change is not only our new reality but also that sustainability/mitigation and resilience/adaptation are both crucial agendas. Interested authors are encouraged to position themselves at any point on the continuum between sustainability and resilience approaches - or opt for a mixture of the two.

Our World Congress will therefore develop solutions towards our urban future, will include **the first Artic Mayors Summit in human history**, **several multilevel roundtables**, including public and private decision-makers, including a session of UN-Habitat Climate Division, COP representatives and other **urban planning stakeholders**.

The confirmed **high-level keynotes are** not less than **Mr. Jeremy Rifkin**, economic and social theorist, and **Prof. Peter Newman**, Curtin University Perth, Councilor and Author, IPCC Board Member.
