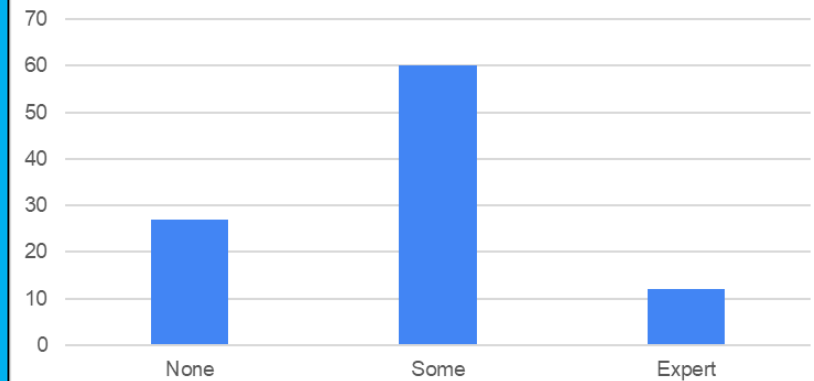
What is your level of knowledge regarding the following: [Sustainable development]

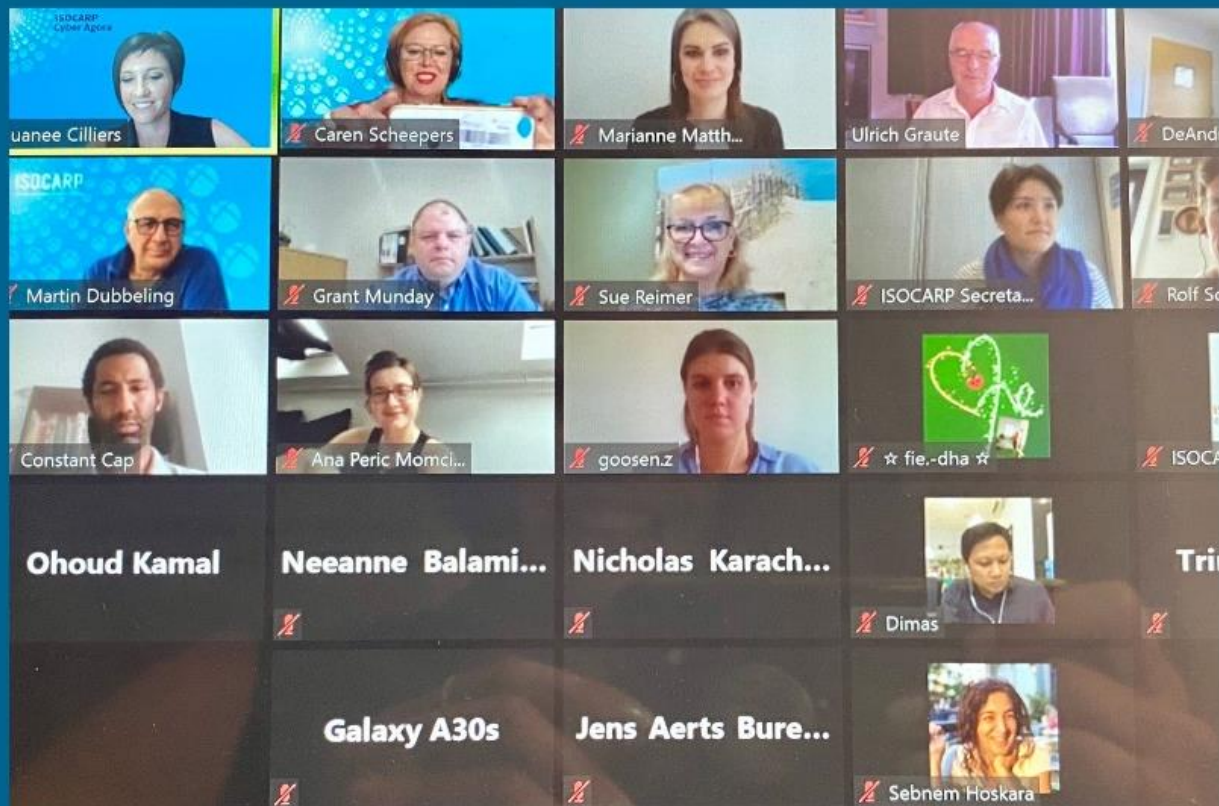
